There shall not be any denial of access or any type of other refusal of this dog, as he needs to accompany her at all times, and in all places, as part of his training to assist and respond, so she may be safe at all times! To do this would be a violation of The Rights of the Disabled.

Civil Code Division 1 sections 54.1, 54.2 & 54.7

Locations Allowed: As other members of the general public, to accommodations, advantages, facilities, and privileges of all common carriers, airplanes, motor vehicles, railroad trains, motor buses, boats or any other public conveyances or modes of transportation, lodging places, places of public, amusement or resort, and other places to which the general public is invited. Any interference from any person, firm, association, or corporation, or the agent of such person that prevents a disabled person from exercising these rights, is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not exceeding \$2,500.00.
